Job Purpose

- 1. To edit and promote Community Dental Health the journal of the British Association for the Study of Community Dentistry (BASCD).
- 2. To work closely with BASCD Council regarding strategic, major management and financial decisions regarding the journal.

Duties and Responsibilities

Key Duties

- 1. To select circa 50 high quality papers for publication each year from about 350 received submissions using the mechanism of peer review.
- 2. To improve the quality of the journal demonstrated by considering a range of relevant metrics.
- 3. To efficiently lead the review process to minimise the delay between submission and publication.
- 4. To ensure the journal content is responsive to the needs of the readership in terms of the articles published.
- 5. To liaise with representatives of EADPH¹ and SESPO², two societies aligned with BASCD, whose membership are readers and contributors to the journal.
- 6. To provide reports to BASCD Council meetings (currently two per year) and to the Annual General Meeting.
- 7. To liaise with the BASCD treasurer regarding the finances of the journal and provide reports prior to the BASCD Council meetings.
- 8. To agree strategic and implement operational changes to the journal as agreed by BASCD Council.
- 9. To review the terms of reference and appointments of the editorial board in collaboration with BASCD Council.
- 10. To work with the Editorial Board.
- 11. To appoint and manage an editorial assistant.
- 12. To maintain a suitable pool of people able to peer review.
- 13. To work with BASCD to ensure the long-term success of the journal.
- 14. To work with the publishers of the journal to ensure a high quality and timely product.
